COMPONENT I: Student / School Achievement

Choose an item.

- iReady Performance Data – Through a Google slide presentation, reviewed growth data for both ELA (15% more students meeting standards) and Math (16% more students meeting standards). Discussed what intervention looks like at Freedom and plan to address further student need.
 - Explore Subgroups – Subgroup data overall looks good with discrepancies in achievement for Black/African American students. 42% meeting standards as compared to the overall school 49%. Not a huge discrepancy in ELA, but still needs to be worked on. Math was 28% compared to schoolwide data at 41%. Overall, this will be a focus for our intervention teams for the second semester.
